

<Application for National Health insurance excluding subscription>

From March 1, 2021, international language study students (D-4-1 visa) students will be automatically registered on 'National health insurance' from the day of 6 months passed after the entry and pay the insurance. However, in case of Some of French and Japanese, they are able to apply for National Health insurance excluding subscription.

1. Excluding subscription target (D-4-1, F, H visa holders)

a. French: All nationalities (By the agreement between the governments, subscription obligation is exempted.)

b. Japanese: Those who registered for Japan health insurance. (Operates medical reimbursement system occurred internationally)

2. Excluding subscription application period: After 5 months pass after entering Korea

3. How to apply
